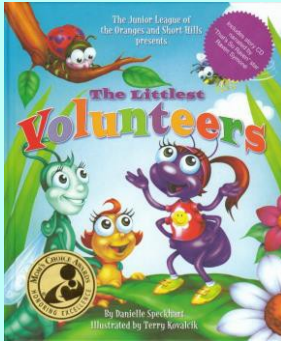


VOLUNTEER CONTEST!
